BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS

Minutes of Public Meeting

November 13, 2017

The meeting of the Talbot County Board of Liquor License Commissioners the (“Board”) was called to order at 10:05 a.m. on Monday, November 13, 2017. Present were Chairman Gary Royer, Commissioner John M. Gottschalk, Commissioner William C. Rolle, Jr., Mary O’Donnell, Assistant County Attorney and Board Secretary, Patricia Finneyfrock.

OLD BUSINESS

- **Motion to Rescind Action of 10/23/17 Granting Piazza of Easton, LLC both a Class B and a Class B-R License**
 - Upon motion by Chairman Royer, seconded by Commissioner Rolle, the Board voted to unanimously rescind the granting of both the Class B and a Class B-R licenses issued in error to Piazza of Easton, LLC.

NEW BUSINESS

- **Application for Transfer of Location of Class E License**

All those in attendance to testify in the matter were sworn in (Applicant, Emily Chandler).

Ms. Chandler testified that she was relocating her existing place of business to an open storefront across the parking lot that offered a greater space to grow her business and was therefore applying for a transfer of her existing Class E License.

Following this discussion the following motion was made.

- Motion made by Commissioner Gottschalk, seconded by Chairman Royer, the Board voted unanimously to grant the transfer of the Class E Liquor License pending receipt of all final approvals from the Health Department and Fire Marshall’s Office, and the payment of all associated fees.
- **Discussion regarding the creation of Class F-A and Class B-R Licenses**

The Board members discussed the ordinance rewrite of March 10, 2012, and the associated changes to the original Class F License. Specifically, the expiration of all existing Class F licenses, the issuance of both the Class F-A and Class B-R Licenses to existing Class F licensees, and the law prohibiting the holding of 2 licenses outside of this change.

There being no further business to discuss, the Board moved to adjourn.
