BOARD OF LIQUOR LICENSE COMMISSIONERS

Minutes of Public Meeting

January 8, 2018

The meeting of the Talbot County Board of Liquor License Commissioners the (“Board”) was called to order at 10:15 a.m. on Monday, January 8, 2018. Present were Chairman Gary Royer, Commissioner John M. Gottschalk, Commissioner William C. Rolle, Jr., Mary O’Donnell, Assistant County Attorney and Board Secretary, Patricia Finneyfrock.

OLD BUSINESS

- Upon motion by Chairman Royer, seconded by Commissioner Gottschalk, the Board voted to unanimously approve the minutes from November 27, 2017.

NEW BUSINESS

- **Election of Officers**

Upon vote, Gary Royer was elected Chairman and John Gottschalk was elected Vice Chair.

- **Application for Transfer of Class E License from C&J Ventures to Wishing Well Liquors, LLC**

All those in attendance to testify in the matter were sworn in (Applicants, Jason Brown and Douglas Ford, and Douglas Walker, Esq.).

Mr. Walker testified as to his personal and professional relationships with both applicants, also noting that they were to receive their TIPS certification training on January 15, 2018, along with two other store employees and that they were applying today for administrative approval pending receipt of the final inspection reports from the State Fire Marshall (a question arose as to the need for the State Fire Marshall’s inspection for a transfer) and Health Department. Mary O’Donnell after a review of the Code opined that a transfer was treated in the same manner as a application for a new license and the inspection from the State Fire Marshall was necessary for compliance.

Upon completion of the testimony given and notice from the Board as to the need for the final approval from the Fire Marshall, the Health Department, TIPS certification, and the payment of all associated fees, the following motion was made:

- Motion made by Commissioner Gottschalk, seconded by Commissioner Rolle, Jr., the Board voted unanimously to approve the application for the transfer of a Class E License from C&J Ventures to Wishing Well Liquors, LLC contingent upon the

Board's receipt of payment of all associated fees and the submittal of the final Permits.
