Chapter 73, Forest Conservation, Section 73.3(B), of the *Talbot County Code* establishes a list of activities that are **Exempt** from the County's Forest Conservation Ordinance, provided the applicant files a **Declaration of Intent** with the Planning and Permits Office assuring compliance with all requirements of the Forest Conservation Act.

Based upon information provided by the applicant stating that the proposed activity will be for a real estate transfer to provide a security, leasehold, or other legal or equitable interest, including a transfer of title, of a portion of a lot or parcel, it has been determined that the proposed activity is **EXEMPT** from the County's Forest Conservation Ordinance. This transfer does not involve a change in land use or new development or redevelopment with associated land disturbing activities. Both the grantor and the grantee must file a **Declaration of Intent** with the Planning and Permits Office.

I hereby verify that the property will be used for the proposed activity stated above and that no regulated activity shall occur on the above-referenced property within five (5) years of the effective date of this **Declaration of Intent**.

I understand that:

- a. The conditions upon which this **Declaration** were granted may not be changed without approval by the Planning and Permits Office; and
 - b. Any regulated activity, as defined by the Talbot County Forest Conservation Ordinance, that is not the subject of this **Declaration of Intent**, will require additional approval.

Notification of the Endangered Species Act
