**RULES & REGULATIONS FOR THE PUBLIC LANDINGS**

- 1) Any person using a Talbot County Public Landing/ Ramp for launching or removing their vessel from the water shall display a valid Talbot County Permit. Parking a boat trailer at a County Landings also requires a valid permit.
- 2) Permit shall be displayed in the following places
  - Boat Trailer – driver side tongues, 1ft. from the hitch.
  - Vehicle – driver side rear bumper if a permit holder has multiple boats/boat trailers, it is recommended to display permit on the boat trailer.
- 3) For more information on Rules and Regulations regarding, Talbot County's Landing please obtain a copy of the Talbot County Ordinance, Chapter 121 at the Department of Parks and Recreation Office, 10028 Ocean Gateway, Easton, MD 21601 410.770.8050 or call the Talbot County Landing Office between 8:00am – 4:30pm, Mon - Fri at 410 – 770 - 8047
- 4) The Department asks all patrons using the landings to pick up and dispose of all trash. Please discard all trash in receptacles provided. If you do litter, you will be fined, \$100.00.
  - All landings are closed between the hours of 11:00pm and 4:00am, if you are a licensed Commercial Waterman going to or from work, current boat Slip Holder or anyone with a valid Talbot County Ramp Permit using ramp to launch a boat, you are permitted during these hours. **No Trespassing.**
  - Vehicles are not to be placed for sale at Public Landings.
  - It is unlawful to block ramps with parked vehicles or vehicle and trailer. No parking at bulkhead. This area is designated for loading and unloading purposes only.
  - **Do Not** dock boats in loading/unloading zones.
  - Camping is prohibited at the Public Landings. Open camp fires are prohibited.
  - Please Obey All "No Fishing" signs where posted.
  - Please **DO NOT** leave boats or equipment on Landings. After 5 days all materials will be removed by the Talbot County Landings Office at the owner's expense.
  - There is absolutely no discharging of fire arms at the Public Landings at any time.
