

## Program Fees

It is the policy of the Talbot County Parks & Recreation Department that program participants help defray the direct costs related to an activity/program through the assessment of fees and charges. However, the department does not wish to exclude any child wishing to participate in any youth program regardless of financial ability. Persons who find themselves in need of assistance may contact the Community Center to inquire about our scholarship program.

## Photo Policy

On occasion, our staff may photograph participants in park programs or at special events. Please be aware that these photos are for our use only and may be used in future brochures, flyers, our web site or social media. By registering for any recreation programs, you agree to allow publication of any photos taken at any program, event or facility.

## Background Check Policy

As a community based organization we strive to create a safe environment for our volunteers, citizens and staff. Volunteer positions require successful completion of a criminal background check through Southeastern Security Consultants, Inc.

## Refund Policy

The Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel, postpone or combine programs due to low enrollment or unforeseen circumstances. If insufficient enrollment causes an activity to be cancelled, participants will receive a full refund. If a participant drops out prior to the start of a program, a refund will be given. To request a refund, call or stop by the Community Center during business hours of 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday. Participants have 30 days after the completion of a program or activity to pick up a refund. After 30 days, the refund will be forfeited and moved into a scholarship fund. A refund will not be given after the start of a program or to team entrants who drop out of a program after the schedule is completed.

## Facility Rental Cancellation Policy

In the event that you need to cancel a facility rental, a 48 hour notice is required to receive a refund. Call or stop by the Community Center during business hours of 8:00AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday. Participants have 30 days after the cancellation of a reservation to pick up a refund. After 30 days, the refund will be forfeited and moved into a scholarship fund.

## Scholarship Program

This program is available for those who meet income guidelines, and is intended to assist those who cannot otherwise pay for program fees. Scholarship amounts are limited and are not available for all programs. To receive a scholarship application and more information about the program, stop by the Talbot Parks & Recreation Office.

## Waiver Required

All participants are required to sign a waiver as Talbot County Parks & Recreation does not provide medical insurance coverage for persons participating in sponsored activities. By registering to participate in recreation programs, each applicant realizes the inherent risk of injury involved and understands the nature of these risks. The applicant agrees to hold Talbot County Parks & Recreation harmless for any injury caused by participation in these programs.

## Inclement Weather

Talbot County Parks & Recreation reserves the right to cancel any program due to inclement weather. If at any time the Parks Department determines that any athletic field is not safe for participant use and/or cannot be used without creating damage or the potential for damage to the field or facility, the fields/facilities may not be used. The decision of Parks & Recreation personnel is final. We ask for your cooperation in caring for our fields and facilities in such a way as to safeguard the participants and preserve our facilities and fields for future and continued use. Parks and Recreation will make every effort to make such decisions in a timely manner but does reserve the right to make such decisions as needed even when advance notice is not possible.

## Lost and Found

If you have lost or misplaced an item in one of the parks or program facilities, please contact the Department office. Articles that are found and turned into the office are kept for 14 days. After that period of time, the items are donated to a local charitable organization or more valuable items are taken to the Police Department. The Parks & Recreation Department is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

## Pets in the Parks

Unless posted, dogs, cats and other pets are permitted in City parks as long as they are kept on leashes or under similar restraints. Owners are responsible for the immediate cleanup, removal and disposal in a lawful manner of pet waste.

## Community Rooms

### Wye Oak Room

This room is 1,250 square feet and provides seating for 64 people with tables and up to 80 people without tables. Amenities included in this room are a projection screen and podium. Rate is \$50/hour

### Chesapeake Room

This room is 1,250 square feet and provides seating for 56 people with tables and up to 72 people without tables.



Amenities included in this room are a projector screen, bathrooms and a catering kitchen with serving island. The rate is \$50 per/hour.

### Skipjack Room

This room is 750 square feet, seats 36 with tables and up to 50 without tables. The rate is \$36/hour.

### Tuckahoe Room

This room is 575 square feet, seats 24 with tables and up to 36 without tables. The rate is \$36/hour.



### Curling Rink

This room is 6,500 square feet, seats 200 with tables and up to 300 without tables. The rate is \$86/hour.

### Arena Rental


The arena is available for rent by the hour for your team's practice or for an all day tournament for hockey, figure skating, basketball, soccer, lacrosse or volleyball.

## Learn to Swim

All Learn to Swim registrations must be completed at least one week before the class begins.

SESSIONS: Session I: July 11–21  
 Session II: July 25–August 4  
 Session III: August 8–18

*All Learn to Swim classes introduce games to make learning new skills an enjoyable and fun experience for the child.*

### Me & My Little One

This class is offered to children 18 months to 2 years old. It will teach the basics of bubble blowing, supported front and back float, locomotion along the wall, assisted front and back kick, introduction to alternating arms, and basic water and sun safety skills. The swim instructor will work with the child as well as the guardian in learning new skills. Adults must accompany the child in the water. Children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper.

### Water Exploration Level I

This class is offered for the beginning swimmer ages 3 and up. It emphasizes comfort in the water, bobbing, front and back float, front and back glide with kick, introduction to alternating arms and basic water and sun safety skills.

**When:** Monday–Thursday  
**Time:** 9:30–10:00 AM or 6:00–6:30 PM at BHCP  
**Where:** GMCP or BHCP

### Fundamental Water Skills Level II

This class is offered to swimmers ages 3 and up who have passed level one or are able to be fully submerged for up to 3 seconds. It emphasizes comfort in the water, beginning back stroke, beginning forward crawl, introduction to rhythmic breathing, front and back floating, and progress from supported to unsupported swimming.

**Fee:** \$40.00 per Session  
**When:** Monday–Thursday  
**Time:** 10:00–10:30 AM or 6:30–7:00 PM at BHCP  
**Where:** GMCP or BHCP

### Stroke Development Level III

This class is offered to swimmers ages 5 and up who have passed level two or are able to submerged and retrieve an object in chest deep water. They also must be able to jump into chest deep water unassisted, and be able to swim without a bubble or flotation device. The child will learn to coordinate front and back crawls with rhythmic breathing, elementary diving skills, treading water, introduction to breast stroke and water and sun safety skills.

**Time:** 10:30–11:00 AM or 7:00–7:30 PM at BHCP  
**Where:** GMCP or BHCP

### Stroke & Turn Level IV

This class is offered to swimmers ages 5 and up who have passed level three and can easily swim laps unassisted. This is advanced training for swimmers to perfect all swim strokes. It will help to improve endurance, fundamentals and speed.

**When:** Monday–Thursday  
**Time:** 11:00–11:30 AM or 7:00–7:30 PM at BHCP  
**Where:** GMCP or BHCP

### Junior Lifeguard Training

Youth ages 12–15 years wanting to learn what is expected of a lifeguard can join us for a two week training session to help prepare them for the lifeguard course. The goal of this aquatics program is to “wet” the appetites of youth who may not have considered lifeguarding as part of their future. All registrants are required to pass the deep end swim test.


