Burn Permit: Open air burning is regulated by Talbot County Environmental Health Department (410) 770-6880 and requires their approval.

<u>Utilities</u>: All public utility companies servicing the structure should be notified, in advance, so they can properly disconnect their utility prior to any demolition activities.

Well and Septic: The Environmental Health Section, Talbot County Health Department, (410) 770-6880 should be notified prior to any demolition activities so they can properly inform you of the requirements of well and septic system closure.

<u>Asbestos</u>: Certain building components may be comprised of asbestos laden material and their removal/disposal is regulated by the Maryland Department of the Environment (410) 631-3000, pursuant to the Code of Maryland Regulations, COMAR 26.11.21, as amended July 16, 1990.

<u>Lead Based Paint</u>: Certain building components may be coated with lead based paint and their removal/disposal is regulated by the Maryland Department of the Environment (800) 766-2706, pursuant to COMAR 26.02.07.

<u>On Site Burial of Debris</u>: The burial of demolition debris on site is regulated by the Maryland Department of the Environment, Solid Waste/Division, (410) 631-3363, pursuant to COMAR 26.04.07.

<u>Disposal of Debris</u>: The disposal of demolition debris off site shall be in accordance with applicable Federal and State regulations for Solid Waste Disposal. The debris shall be transported to a regulated Solid Waste Disposal Facility only.

I understand that I am responsible for having all utilities disconnected, cable, electric, telephone, propane, natural gas, kerosene, fuel oil, well, septic, etc, in the proper manner before demolition may commence. I, the homeowner, will contact the utility companies and agencies noted above and obtain all appropriate permits before beginning demolition.
