C. 2019 Work Plan

1. Regarding seeking an HPC Intern, Holly reported no response from Salisbury University. Holly plans to expand outreach to Chesapeake College and Washington College.
2. MHT Capital Grants application project: no matching funds required for historic structures most at risk. The Committee can begin to think what project could qualify.
3. Galloway House has not yet moved; the building is being prepared to move. The project is on hold to wait for favorable weather.
4. There is an opportunity for onsite archaeology to explore the remainder of the Galloway site. Port Street and other sites are also undocumented. With the property owner's permission, a dig can be a local effort rather than an internship that can also create public awareness for the HPC.
