INVITATION TO BIDDERS**

**TITLE: REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS – TILGHMAN ON THE CHESAPEAKE RESILIENT GREEN
INFRASTRUCTURE DESIGN, TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND**

Sealed bids for this proposal shall be accepted by the Office of the Talbot County Manager, South Wing, Suite 13, Talbot County Courthouse, 11 N. Washington Street, Easton, Maryland 21601 until **NOON** local time on **Friday, June 25, 2021**, at which time they shall be opened and read aloud.

The Scope of Work for the project involves working with Talbot County Government staff, Tilghman on the Chesapeake Community Association, and the University of Maryland Sea Grant Extension to design a living shoreline with marsh migration corridor, meadow habitat, and stormwater outflow components that increase resilience of this waterfront community along Harris Creek (approximately 38°42'17.21"N, 76°20'3.98"W). Practices will be designed to adapt to sea level rise and coastal storm impacts, and to address erosion and stormwater runoff. This project will serve as a demonstration site for the Talbot County Green Infrastructure Plan.

A MANDATORY SITE MEETING has been scheduled for **Tuesday, June 15, 2021 at 2:00 p.m.** To reach the site, take Maryland State Highway 33 (Tilghman Island Road) and cross over the bridge and Knapps Narrows onto Tilghman Island. Turn left into Tilghman on the Chesapeake on Island Club Road. Turn left and continue on Island Club Road to Avalon Court. Turn right on to Avalon Court and park at the cul de sac on Avalon Court. From there, it is a short walk to the shoreline.

Following the site meeting, questions may be submitted in writing through **Friday, June 18, 2021**.

Bid Documents may be obtained in person or by mail from the Talbot County Department of Planning and Zoning, 215 Bay Street, Suite 2, Easton, Maryland 21601. The bid package is also online at http://www.talbotcountymd.gov/index.php?page=Planning_and_Zoning.

Proposers must provide a **Concept Plan**, along with the “*Proposal for Design Services*”
