

**Bellevue Village/Waterfront Master Plan
BELLEVUE COMMUNITY DESIGN MEETING**

Talbot County is sponsoring a village and waterfront community design workshop at the Bellevue Methodist Church on Saturday, October 22 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. to advance the Bellevue Village/Waterfront Master Plan. The workshop is open to the public and those interested in helping to lend a guiding hand to the Village of Bellevue's waterfront and village plan are encouraged to attend.

The workshop will focus on discussing additional details for four specific areas that came out of the Community Visioning Meeting held on August 22, 2016 and through the community survey:

- Addressing the issues of Bellevue Landing Park including
 - The overflow trailer parking on busy summer weekends
 - Enhancing the restroom facilities
 - Establishing a safer pedestrian pathway to connect the community with the park
 - Slowing vehicular operating speeds on Bellevue Road
- Addressing the issues of the maintenance of Bellevue's streets (including both private streets and County roads)
- Addressing the issues of the development of "Bellevue Gardens," especially how new development would be seen from the community and potential changes to Poplar Lane that may be needed depending upon the number of homes that the owners wish to build
- Addressing the issues of a proposed barge landing at the former W.A. Turner and Sons landing on Tar Creek

In addition to Talbot County Planning staff, Talbot County's Director of Parks and Superintendent of Roads will be available to discuss more detailed options for Bellevue Landing Park and for discussing ideas for improving road maintenance in Bellevue.
