PERSON WANTED FOR ROBBERY



PERRY'S CORNER STORE, CORDOVA, TALBOT COUNTY

On March 3, 2006 at 0730 hours the A-1 Liquor Store (Perry's Corner Store) was robbed by a Black Male with a handgun. It was apparent that the suspect and potential accomplices were familiar with the operations of the store. A large quantity of cash was stolen in the robbery.

SUSPECT: Black Male, 20-30 yrs., 5-11, slender to medium build. The suspect was armed with a long barreled, small caliber revolver. Suspect was wearing a blue waist length coat with a hood; with hood strap pulled across his mouth, blue jeans and white tennis shoes.

SUSPECT VEHICLE: After the robbery the suspect fled in a stolen 1998 Plymouth van, purple in color with Delaware tags PC 146264. The stolen vehicle was recovered two miles from the store on MD Rt. 303 (near the old Bethany House). The vehicle had been stolen from Blades, DE on March 2, 2006 at 2030 hours. Evidence determined that another vehicle had been parked on Rt. 303 and was used as the getaway vehicle after the stolen van was driven from the store. Witnesses described a white vehicle (NFD) in the area where the stolen van was recovered after the robbery. One witness described the white vehicle as an older model Buick with rust spots on the rear.

When the van was stolen from Blades, DE, witnesses saw a Black Male, 6'02", slender build, 20-30 yrs, facial hair/goatee, NFD, taking the van. The suspect got out of a white late model vehicle with "three round stop lights on each side" (NFD) before entering and stealing the van.
