# C. 2003 International Mechanical Code®

Talbot County hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the 2003 *International Mechanical Code*®, (including Appendix Chapters A and B), as published by the International Code Council, Inc., as minimum standards for commercial mechanical construction within Talbot County, Maryland.

# D. 2003 International Residential Code®

Talbot County hereby adopts and incorporates by reference Chapters 12-24, of the 2003 *International Residential Code*®, as published by the International Code Council, Inc., as minimum standards for residential mechanical construction within Talbot County, Maryland.

E. Talbot County hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the 2002 Edition of the National Fuel Gas Code, ANZI Z223.1, NFPA 54, as published by the American Gas

Association and the National Fire Protection Association, as minimum gas installation standards for both commercial and residential construction.
