

**TALBOT COUNTY PUBLIC NOTICE  
CORRECTED**

THE COUNTY COUNCIL ADOPTED BILL NO. 1185, AS AMENDED, ON AUGUST 24, 2010, TO ESTABLISH ALCOHOL AWARENESS TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSEES. BILL 1185 REQUIRES ALL EMPLOYEES TO SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE TRAINING IN AN APPROVED ALCOHOL AWARENESS PROGRAM WITHIN 180 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF HIRE, OR BY APRIL 21, 2011, WHICHEVER IS LATER. THE BILL ALLOWS THE LIQUOR INSPECTOR TO GRANT AN EXTENSION NOT TO EXCEED 60 DAYS FOR LICENSEES WITH LESS THAN THREE EMPLOYEES WHOSE BUSINESSES WOULD SUFFER UNDUE HARDSHIP, ESTABLISHES PENALTIES, AND SPECIFIES THAT THE BILL DOES NOT CREATE OR ENLARGE ANY CIVIL CAUSE OF ACTION OR CRIMINAL PROCEEDING AGAINST A LICENSEE.
