SECTION ONE: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND, that § 190 of the Talbot County Code entitled "Zoning, Subdivision and Land Development" is amended as set forth herein.

Article III Land Uses

1 §190-30. Bed-and-Breakfast

- 2 A. A use certificate is required.
- 3 B. The use certificate shall be renewed annually. Renewal may require a site inspection.
- C. In the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area, a bed-and-breakfast shall only be permitted in a principal dwelling existing as of August 13, 1989. Enlargement of the principal dwelling may not exceed 50 percent of the gross floor area which existed as of August 13, 1989.
- 7 D. Minimum lot size in an RC (Rural Conservation) or RR (Rural Residential) Zoning District: two acres.
- 9 E. Bed-and-breakfast uses shall be a minimum of 500 feet apart. For purposes of this subsection the measurement shall not be taken over navigable water and shall be taken between structures used for the bed-and-breakfast use and not between property lines.
- F. A bed-and-breakfast enterprise shall have no more than six guest bedrooms, accommodating no more than 12 guests at any one time. No paying guest shall stay on any one visit for more than 30 days.
- 15 G. Guestrooms shall have no primary outside entrance.
- 16 H. Guest parking shall be provided in a side or rear yard.
- 17 I. Meal service is limited to one daily meal between 4:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. per paying overnight guest. Meal service is subject to State Health Department approval of food preparation areas;
