A BILL TO AMEND BILL NO. 1261 THE 2014-2015 ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CURRENT EXPENSE BUDGET THROUGH FOURTH QUARTER TRANSFERS AND SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATIONS

BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: The County Council authorizes the transfer of funds between departments of the Current Expense Budget as authorized in Section 615 of the Talbot County Charter.

SECTION 2: The Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015 is hereby amended as noted in Exhibit A.

SECTION 3: And be it further enacted, that this Ordinance will take effect on the date of enactment.
