**A BILL TO AMEND BILL NO. 1303, THE 2015-2016 ANNUAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FROM UNANTICIPATED REVENUES TO CERTAIN DEPARTMENTS IN THE CURRENT EXPENSE BUDGET**

WHEREAS, under Section 617 of the Talbot County Charter, upon the recommendation of the County Manager, the County Council may make additional appropriations from contingency funds, revenue received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates or revenues, received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the current fiscal year to meet a public emergency affecting life, health, or property;

WHEREAS, the County Manager has recommended the additional appropriations and has certified in writing that such funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 is hereby amended by making supplemental appropriations or revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget as follows:

SECTION TWO: And be it further enacted, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 is hereby amended by making supplemental appropriations of such funds as enumerated in Section 1 of this Ordinance to the accounts listed below in the amounts set forth:

SECTION THREE: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that if any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason in a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or any other application of the Bill which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and for this purpose the provisions of this Bill are declared severable.

SECTION FOUR: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the title and a summary of this Bill shall be published once on the first publication date after enactment of the Bill in accordance with County Charter § 213(c). The title is not a substantive part of this Bill. If the Bill is amended, the title may be administratively revised if required to conform the title to the content of the Bill as finally enacted.

SECTION FIVE: AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the Publishers of the Talbot County Code or the Talbot County Office of Law, in consultation with and subject to the approval of the County Manager, may make non-substantive corrections to codification, style, capitalization, punctuation, grammar, spelling, and any internal or external reference or citation included in this Bill, as finally adopted, that are incorrect or obsolete, with no further action required by the County Council. All such corrections shall be adequately referenced and described in an editor's note following the section affected.

SECTION SIX: And be it further enacted, that this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the preservation of life, health, or property; and will take effect on the date of enactment.
