A BILL TO ESTABLISH THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE SHERIFF FOR TALBOT COUNTY TO BECOME EFFECTIVE FOR TERMS BEGINNING IN AND AFTER 2018

SECTION ONE: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF TALBOT COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Chapter 155, of the Talbot County Code entitled Sheriff, shall be and is hereby amended as set forth herein.

Chapter 155, SHERIFF

§ 155-5. Salary

The salary of the Sheriff of Talbot County shall be established at the beginning of each term at the rate of \$~~75,000~~88,500, to include any cumulative cost-of-living ~~and/or step~~ salary increases that the governing body of Talbot County may grant to County employees. Upon re-election of an incumbent, the then existing salary shall not re-base. Once established, the salary of the Sheriff shall not be increased, except for cumulative cost-of-living and/or step salary adjustments, or decreased, during the remainder of the four-year term of office.

SECTION TWO: Severability Clause. Should any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Bill, as enacted, be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision or holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof. The County Council

intends to enact each such provision individually, and each shall stand alone, if necessary, and be enforced regardless of the invalidity of any other provision(s).

SECTION THREE: BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that in accordance with Article III, Section 35, of the Maryland Constitution, any increase or decrease in compensation is to become effective for terms beginning in and after the year 2018.


