**A BILL TO AMEND BILL NO. 1070, MODIFYING THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION OF DUTCHMANS LANE CULVERT AND BRIDGE**

SECTION 1: The construction of new facilities and/or the renovation of existing facilities for County office space is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the planning, design, acquisition, construction, renovation, furnishing and equipping of new facilities and/or the renovation of existing facilities for County office space, including improvements for public safety, accessibility and parking.

SECTION 2: The inter-project transfer of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) from the capital project for “Property Acquisition/County Parking” to the capital project for “County Office/Planning/Construction/Renovation” is hereby authorized.

SECTION 3: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$4,500,000 of County funds for construction of new facilities and/or the renovation of existing facilities for County office space. This represents an increase of \$2,700,000 over prior authorization. The project will be funded by Development Impact Fees of approximately \$420,000 and County funds of approximately \$4,080,000. The increase from the prior authorization is comprised of an increase in Development Impact Fees of approximately \$420,000, an increase in County funds of approximately \$1,780,000, and the inter-project transfer of \$500,000 cited above.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance will take effect sixty (60) calendar days from the date of enactment.
