A BILL TO AMEND THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW EASTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

WHEREAS, Bill No. 1369 authorized architectural and engineering fees associated with the construction of the Easton Elementary School;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: The construction of Easton Elementary School is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the planning, design, preparation of construction documents and construction and furnishing of a new Easton Elementary School and the demolition and modification of the existing elementary schools to be used during construction, and the cost of issuance of any bonds needed to finance the project.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$31,000,000 for the project. Borrowing to finance this capital project is authorized. Acceptance of State funds for this capital project is authorized. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all associated and incidental and customary costs and charges associated with and reasonably required for financing, planning, design, construction, and completion of the project. The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to borrow up to \$13,795,000 for Talbot County's share of design and construction of the Easton Elementary School Project and any related cost of issuance of bonds or other borrowing expenses used to finance this project. The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$12,000,000 in State funds for this project. The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$4,205,000 in funding from the Capital Projects Fund and \$1,000,000 in Development Impact funds for this project. This represents an increase of \$28,300,000 over prior authorization. The increase is funded by additional long term borrowing of \$11,095,000, State funding of \$12,000,000, funds from the Capital Projects Fund of \$4,205,000 and Development Impact fees of \$1,000,000.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance will take effect sixty (60) calendar days from the date of enactment.

SECTION 1: Talbot County's share of the upgrade of the Upper Maryland Eastern Shore Radio System is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the replacement of equipment for Fire/EMS, Law Enforcement Local Government subscribers, and the upgrade or replacement of the 800 MHz infrastructure and installation of a fire paging system. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all incidental and customary costs and charges reasonably necessary for completion of the project.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$9,141,200 in funding for this project. Borrowing to finance this capital project is authorized. The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to borrow up to \$6,716,300 for Talbot County's share of design and construction of the Upper Maryland Eastern Shore Radio System and any related cost of issuance of bonds or other borrowing expenses used to finance this project. The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$2,424,900 in funding from the Capital Projects Fund for this project. This represents an increase of \$115,000 over prior authorization. The increase is funded by additional funds from the Capital Projects Fund of \$115,000.

A BILL TO AMEND THE APPROPRIATION FOR THE DREDGING OF TONGERS BASIN, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF BOAT SLIPS AND THE REPAIR AND/OR REPLACEMENT OF THE BULKHEAD AT TONGERS BASIN, TILGHMAN, MARYLAND

WHEREAS, Bill No. 1345 increased the appropriation for dredging and boat slip construction, Bill No. 1284 authorized the dredging of Tongers Basin, and Bill No. 1196 authorized the construction of boat slips at Tongers Basin located on Tilghman Island;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: Repair and /or replacement of the bulkhead, dredging of Tongers Basin and construction of boat slips at Tongers Basin, Tilghman Island, is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the planning, design and mechanical/hydraulic dredging of the basin and the disposal of dredge materials and the design and construction of fifteen (15) boats slips at Tongers Basin and a boat slip for the Tilghman Volunteer Fire Company's Emergency Vessel, including miscellaneous electrical, marine pump-out and parking lot improvements, the planning, design and repair of the existing bulkhead and/or the construction of a replacement bulkhead. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all incidental and customary costs and charges associated with and reasonably necessary for completion of the project.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$629,000 in for this project. The project will be funded by federal and State grants of approximately \$114,000 and funding from the Capital Projects Fund of approximately \$515,000 for this project. Acceptance of federal and State Grants for this capital project is authorized. This represents an increase of \$300,000 over prior authorizations. The increase is funded by additional funds from the Capital Projects Fund of \$300,000.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance will take effect sixty (60) calendar days from the date of enactment.
