A BILL TO AMEND BILL No. 1366, THE APPROPRIATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO BLACK DOG ALLEY

WHEREAS Bill No. 1366 authorized improvements to Black Dog Alley;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: The improvement of Black Dog Alley is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, surveying and right of way acquisition for the future design, engineering, property acquisition, drainage improvements, and construction and widening of Black Dog Alley Road between Maryland Rt. 328 (Matthewstown Road) to Maryland Rt. 331 (Dover Road) in order to improve traffic safety.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$725,000 for the Black Dog Alley project. The project will be funded by Development Impact Fees of approximately \$44,500 and funds from the Capital Projects Fund of approximately \$680,500. This represents an increase of \$475,000 over prior authorizations. The increase is funded by additional funds from the Capital Projects fund of \$475,000.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance will take effect sixty (60) calendar days from the date of enactment.



SECTION 1: The purchase of Total Nitrogen (TN) credits and Total Phosphorus (TP) credits from the oysters being grown and harvested in Talbot County is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the purchase of TN and TP Credits from the oyster ~~aquaculture~~ industry to offset TN and TP discharge from wastewater treatment plants in the County. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all incidental and customary costs and charges associated with and reasonably necessary for completion of the project.

SECTION 1: A sewer system for Ferry Point Marina and surrounding areas to potentially include properties located on Ferry Point Court, Ferry Point Drive and Marina Drive in Trappe, Maryland is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the design, engineering and construction of a grinder pump /low-pressure sewer system with a community-based wastewater treatment plant meeting Enhanced Nutrient Removal (ENR) technology treatment limitations or conveyance system to an existing wastewater treatment plant. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all incidental and customary costs and charges associated with and reasonably necessary for completion of the project and the cost of issuance of any bonds needed to finance the project.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$2,600,000 for the project. Borrowing to finance this capital project is authorized. Acceptance of federal and/or State grant funds for this capital project is authorized. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all associated and incidental and customary costs and charges associated with and reasonably required for financing, planning, design, construction, and completion of the project. This project will be funded by approximately \$1,250,000 of federal and State grants and \$1,350,000 of funds from long-term borrowing. The increase is funded by additional federal and State grants of approximately \$500,000, and long-term borrowing of approximately \$600,000.

SECTION 1: The Region II (St. Michaels) sewer rehabilitation and improvements is hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the repair, maintenance and replacement of the infrastructure of the Region II (St. Michaels) wastewater treatment collection system. This infrastructure includes wastewater treatment sewer lines and pump stations in and around the Town of St. Michaels including the design, engineering, construction and reconstruction of these items.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$8,595,000 for the completion of this project. Borrowing to finance this capital project and the acceptance of federal and State grants for this project is hereby authorized. This represents an increase of \$1,400,000 over prior authorizations. The increase is funded by additional federal and State grants of approximately \$1,050,000 and additional long-term borrowing of approximately \$350,000. This project is funded by federal and State grants of approximately \$6,793,000 and approximately \$1,802,000 in funds from long-term borrowing. Approval of this capital project includes authorization to expend funds, not to exceed the total amount of the appropriation, for all associated transactional costs and for incidental and customary costs and charges associated with, and reasonably required for, financing, planning, design, construction, and completion of the project. All costs incurred for this capital project shall be repaid by the users of the Region II (St. Michaels) Wastewater Treatment facility.

The project will be funded by federal and State grants of approximately \$1,350,000, Development Impact Fees of approximately \$372,000 and approximately \$708,000 in funds from the Capital Projects Fund. Acceptance of federal and State grants for this capital project is authorized. This represents an increase of \$300,000 over prior authorizations. The increase is funded by additional funds from the Capital Projects Fund of approximately \$300,000.
