# Proposed Amendment to Resolution 148 Region II Sewer Service Allocation Policy

Proposed Amendment: Page 7, Section 5 C. "Maximum Allocation", to read, "Annual Capacity, if any, remaining at the end of a calendar year shall be [strike the following] added back into the total available Expanded Capacity. [add the following] available for allocation in the ensuing calendar year in addition to the Annual Capacity calculated under Section 4. E.

## 1. <u>Purpose of the Proposed Amendment</u>:

To make unutilized annual capacity, if any, available for allocation in an ensuing calendar year rather than adding it back into total available capacity for pro-rata allocation over the remaining life of the Plant.

#### 2. Substantive:

This is a Resolution, not an Ordinance, and is therefore not subject to the requirement in Charter § 213 (d) that substantive amendments be re-advertised for another public hearing prior to adoption.

### C. Maximum allocation.

To prevent Annual Capacity from being depleted by a single project, no more than fifty percent (50%) of the unallocated Annual Capacity for any Sewer Service Area may be allocated to any single project, as determined by the County Engineer, during any calendar year. Unallocated Annual Capacity, if any, remaining at the end of a calendar year shall be added back into the total available Expanded Capacity. available for allocation in the ensuing calendar year in addition to the Annual Capacity calculated under Section 4. E. Unfilled requests for allocation, if any, shall be placed on a waiting list and filled in order from the list.
