A RESOLUTION TO ELIMINATE THE TWO-TERM LIMIT FOR REAPPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE VILLAGE CENTER BOARD

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2006 the County Council adopted Resolution 127, as amended, creating the Village Center Board (the "Board") and establishing a limitation on the ability to reappoint a Board member to more than a single additional term; and,

WHEREAS, the restriction on Council's ability to reappoint an existing member to more than a single additional term has resulted in the loss of experienced members and has hampered the Board's effectiveness

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Council for Talbot County, Maryland

5. **Terms.** Each member shall serve a term of three years. Initial terms shall be staggered so that approximately one third (1/3) of the terms of the entire membership expire each year. Terms shall begin on July 1 and expire on June 30 the third year thereafter. Members shall continue to serve until a successor is appointed and qualified. Members appointed for the unexpired portion of an existing term shall serve the balance of the existing term. ~~Members may be reappointed for a single additional term.~~

Except as amended hereby, the terms of the Resolution 127, as amended and adopted January 26, 2006, shall remain in full force and effect.
