**The Scope of Work** in general includes installation of small diameter sewer force mains in existing developed areas of the county for the purpose of providing public sewer service. The scope of this project is to provide the "backbone" sewer force main system with service stubs, whereby individual lot connections can be made at a later date, as part of Phase 3 of the Resolution 235 project. The project scope also includes the installation of lot valves, pressure sewer cleanout assemblies, air vacuum relief valves, sewer system testing, final seeding and stabilization for disturbed areas, final site cleanup and other items as described in the construction drawings and specifications.

**A Pre-Bid Conference** will be held at Talbot County Public Works, Conference Room 1, located at 215 Bay Street, Suite 6, Easton, Maryland at 10:00 am on **Friday, April 14, 2023**. Attendance at the Pre-Bid Conference is not mandatory, but bidders are strongly encouraged to attend.

Bids will not be accepted from bidders who have not registered, obtained and paid for the full set of Construction and Bid Submission Documents.

Bid security shall be furnished as stipulated in the project Specifications, Information for Bidders.

Funding sources for the project will include local funding and the State of Maryland Water Quality Revolving Loan Fund (SRF). Prevailing federal wage rates under the Davis-Bacon Act and the use of American iron and steel apply to this project. Contractors must also demonstrate good faith efforts to comply with the Maryland Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program (DBE). Information regarding the SRF and associated requirements is included in the bid documents.
