NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING STUDY

The Talbot County Department of Public Works will conduct a series of public meetings to obtain the public's input on solid waste and recycling issues within Talbot County. Topics anticipated to be discussed include, but are not limited to, the closing of the Mid-Shore 1 Regional Landfill (located in Talbot County) in December 2010; the opening of the new Mid-Shore 2 Regional Landfill (to be located in Caroline County; current in-county and Mid-Shore regional solid waste and recycling management practices; and options/citizen preferences for the handling of trash and/or recyclables generated within Talbot County once the Mid-Shore 1 Landfill closes.
