A special meeting of the Talbot County Board of Elections was held on October 8, 2024, in the meeting room indicated above. President MacKinnon called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and noted that a quorum was present.

The meeting was called to provide an update on Election Judge assignments since the Board had already approved the appointment of the judges prior to the primary election.

There are 18 people (4 Democrats, 13 Republicans and 1 other) who still need to finish training and will be used, if needed, to fill in numbers from the Primary. Their training will be completed within the next two weeks.

Ms. Lovelady asked if we will see the exact location numbers today and Ms. Stafford said yes.
