

**A BILL TO AUTHORIZE IMPROVEMENTS AT THE BELLEVUE FERRY LANDING**

BE IT ENACTED BY the County Council of Talbot County, Maryland, as follows:

SECTION 1: Improvements at the Bellevue Ferry Landing are hereby authorized as a capital project. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the design and replacement of ramp, pulleys, dolphins, cross members and other miscellaneous work that is required by the National Bridge Inspection System (NBIS) inspection report on the Ferry Ramp for vehicle loading and unloading.

SECTION 2: The Talbot County Council is hereby authorized to expend up to \$200,000 for this project. The project will be funded by State and Federal grants of approximately \$160,000 and approximately \$40,000 in funds from the Capital Projects Fund.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance will take effect sixty (60) calendar days from the date of enactment.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance will take effect sixty (60) calendar days from the date of enactment.


